## FIND A SITE NEAR YOU

Take back drop boxes are located at safe medication return sites. Beginning in December, 2020, specific locations in all communities around the state will now be able to take back prescription medications. More information on locations will be available soon on **MedProject.org**



75 percent of opioid misuse starts with people using medication that wasn't prescribed for them, usually taken from a friend or family member.<sup>1</sup>



Opioid pain medications prescribed by doctors include oxycodone, hydrocodone, codeine, morphine and many others.<sup>2</sup>
